

Procedure: Use and Acceptance of Laboratory Evaluation Results for Cosmetic Product Certification

1. Purpose

To ensure that only valid, relevant, and up-to-date laboratory evaluation results are used when granting a Certificate of Conformity (CoC) for cosmetic products, in compliance with SFDA requirements.

2. Scope

This procedure applies to all cosmetic product certification applications handled by [CAB Name] under the SFDA Cosmetic Products CoC Scheme.

4. Definitions

Evaluation Results – Laboratory test reports, safety assessments, or compliance data used to determine conformity.

Validity Period – The maximum time allowed between the laboratory test report date and the CoC application date, as per SFDA rules.

5. Responsibilities

Certification Officer: Verifies the validity of evaluation results before processing applications.

Technical Reviewer: Ensures the laboratory results meet the required SFDA validity criteria.

Quality Manager: Monitors compliance with this procedure and maintains related records.

6. Procedure Steps

1. 6.1 Receipt of Application
 - Upon receiving an application, the Certification Officer logs it in the Certification Register.
 - All supporting documents, including laboratory test reports, are collected.
2. 6.2 Verification of Test Report Validity
 - Confirm the laboratory is SFDA-approved or recognized.

- Check the issue date of the laboratory report:
 - For cosmetic products, the laboratory report must be dated within [X months] prior to the application date.
 - Any report older than the allowed validity period is not acceptable and must be re-tested.
- Ensure the product name, batch number, and formulation in the report match the application details.

3. 6.3 Decision on Acceptance

- If results are valid: proceed with the technical review.
- If results are expired or non-compliant:
 - Inform the applicant in writing that re-testing is required.
 - Do not proceed until updated results are provided.

4. 6.4 Documentation

- Maintain a copy of the test report in the certification file.
- Record the verification outcome in the Test Report Validity Checklist.

5. 6.5 Final Certification Decision

- Only after confirming that evaluation results are valid and compliant shall the CoC be granted.
